


Parent/Carer Information Summer 1

Learning Challenge Questions	What kind of landscape can you see through your window? What did the landscape look like 10 years ago? What will the landscape look like in 10 years time? What can we grow on the windowsill? How can we draw and paint landscapes?
In English we shall learn about	We will continue to develop our descriptive writing and our use of conjunctions. We will continue to develop our spelling by adding suffixes. We will write our own narrative for the wordless picture book "Window" by Jeannie Baker. We will write our own "Window" story. 
In Maths we shall learn about	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Time• Money• Shape• Addition and subtraction• Multiplication and division
In Science.....	Working Scientifically We will continue to develop our skills when working scientifically through questions, observations and performing simple tests. We will gather and record data to help in answering questions.
In Geography and history...	We will look at maps and plans of our local area. We will create our own maps and plans in different formats. Will explore how the local area has changed over time. We will think about different landscapes and environments and how they are changing.
In Art...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will explore how to use a range of materials to create landscapes.• We will explore and compare famous landscape paintings.• We will learn to work alone and collaborate with others on projects.• We will review our work and that of others• We will identify how we could change or improve our work.
In SEAL we shall be thinking about	Relationships - exploring our feelings in the context of our families and important friendships. Developing self-awareness, managing feelings and empathy.
In Religious Education	We will learn about the festival of Passover and what it means to Jewish people.
In Music we shall be	We will be listening to and performing music and developing our own scores.
In ICT we shall learn about	We will learn how to edit photos to create different effects.
