### Parent / Carer Information



The theme for this half term is: Who will you be when you grow up?

Teachers: Mrs Jones and Mrs Hutt. Teaching Assistants: Miss Woodruff and Mrs Kirby.

In English we will	Read and respond to stories with familiar settings by well known authors. Write our own stories with familiar settings. Work on writing 'Super Sentences!' Think about who we want to be when we grow up and write about our dreams for the future.
In Numeracy we shall	Work on numbers and place value. Use measures, especially length and mass. Work on addition and subtraction, initially to 20, then 100.
In Science we will	Carry out investigations related to our bodies and growth. Observe seasonal change as we move from Summer to Autumn.
In Music we will	Explore sound in our environment. Use percussion instruments. Learn songs for Harvest. (Year Twos will be involved in Music 360.)
In Art and DT we will	Look at and discuss self-portraits by famous artists. Practise drawing people and faces. Draw each other and ourselves from observation. Know primary and secondary colours and refer to them in our own work.

In History we shall	Explore our own personal histories and family background. Find out about significant people who have done important jobs. Participate in Black History Month (October.)
In SEAL we will	Focus on New Beginnings and settling into our new class. Devise new class rules.
In PE we will focus on	Rugby skills. Gymnastics - large apparatus PE.
In RE we will think about	Year 1 - Why is the church important to Christians? Year 2 - Special places.
