The theme for this half term is: Why do puddles come and go?

<p>In English</p> 	<p>We will listen and respond to poems related to the seaside. We will discuss the difference between poetry and prose and recognise the key features of poems. We will read poems as a class and independently. We will write poems together, use poetry writing frames and write our own poems.</p> <p>We will watch the short film "Something Fishy" and use it as a basis for narrative writing.</p> <p>Author study</p> <p>We will read Ivy and the Lonely Raincloud and use the text to learn about spelling, punctuation and grammar. We will also develop our skills of inference.</p>
<p>In Numeracy we shall learn about</p> 	<p>Time - telling the time to o'clock and half past.</p> <p>Multiplication and division and how they are the inverse of each other.</p> <p>Addition and subtraction.</p> <p>We will also consolidate work we have done on measures over the year.</p>
<p>In Science we will</p> 	<p>Carry out investigations related to water and the weather.</p> <p>Learn about the water cycle.</p> <p>Observe seasonal change as we move into summer.</p>
<p>In Music we will</p> 	<p>Explore timbre, tempo and dynamics.</p> <p>We will learn and sing seaside songs.</p>
<p>In SEAL we shall learn about</p> 	<p>Transition and change. We will think about how we have changed since we started school.</p> <p>We will prepare ourselves for moves to new classes and schools and think about making new friends.</p>

<p>In Geography we shall</p> 	<p>Identify the features of the seaside and discuss the difference between physical and human features. Compare Broomhill and Bridlington and give opinions on each. Which do you prefer and why?</p>
<p>In Art and DT we will</p> 	<p>Look at famous paintings of the sea and the seaside. Practise mixing colours and work on our painting skills. Create our own seaside pictures. Use wax resist to create puddle pictures.</p>
<p>In PE we will focus on</p> 	<p>Athletics. We will show our new skills at Sports Day! We will also continue to refine our movements in gymnastics.</p>
<p>In ICT</p> 	<p>We will retrieve information and images from the internet. We will practise our word processing skills.</p>
<p>In RE</p> 	<p>We will learn about the celebration of Eid and discuss how special items, costume and food are important to Muslims at this time.</p>
