In Literacy and Communication and Language we shall learn about	<p>Know that print carries meaning and is read left to right.</p> <p>We will recognise letters from the alphabet and say their names and sounds.</p> <p>We will give meaning to marks we make and see in the environment.</p>

	<p>We will write for a purpose in different situations.</p> <p>We will be confident to ask adults and friends for help.</p> <p>We will initiate conversations and show friendly behaviours, and to listen to others when they speak.</p> <p>We will hear and identify the initial sounds in words.</p> <p>We will listen to stories, and talk about the characters and events.</p>
In Mathematics we shall learn about	<p>Counting objects, actions and other things using 1:1 correspondence.</p> <p>Recognise numerals in the environment.</p> <p>Writing numerals accurately.</p> <p>Associating a numeral with an amount, and matching these well.</p> <p>Comparing groups, and recognising when they have the same number or using vocab such as more/less, greater than/less than.</p> <p>Identifying simple shapes and describing them.</p>
In Understanding the World we shall learn about	<p>People and communities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognising special times for myself and others I know. • Being interested in jobs that people do and also understanding different ways of life. • Talk about things that are special about me, and how I am different to other people. <p>The world-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To talk about and ask questions about the natural world about me. • To talk about things I have observed, such as plants and animals. • To show care and concern for living things in the environment (Such as plants and particularly animals). <p>Technology</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To complete a simple computer program. • Using ICT to interact with age appropriate software.
In Expressive arts and Design	<p>Join in with dancing and expressive activities.</p> <p>Sing familiar songs, and dance when I hear music that I know.</p> <p>Use what I find in the environment to create my own imaginative role play activities,</p> <p>Use construction equipment to create my own structures and enclosures.</p> <p>To represent people and objects using a range of different media and techniques.</p>
In SEAL we shall learn about	<p>New Beginnings– We shall be learning about new beginnings I school, and how we can all feel different and help each other during this time of change. We will generate ideas also about how we can all contribute to a happy school.</p>
In PE and Physical Development we shall learn about	<p>Rugby - We will develop ball control skills, and passing, throwing and catching a range of different balls of all shapes and sizes.</p> <p>We will also use gymnastics equipment to practice travelling and moving over, under, and around equipment safely.</p>

In ICT we shall learn about	Interacting with software that is appropriate for our age. Controlling ICT programmes effectively.
