The theme for this half term is: **How would you like to travel?**

To support the school theme of 'How would you like to travel?' we will be reading stories related to vehicles, travel, journeys and jobs relating to these themes.

<p>Possible child led learning opportunities</p>	<p>Role play travelling, driving, home corner activities, jobs relating to travel and roles involved in family travel.</p> <p>Building and constructing vehicles (large loose parts outdoors, using creative area resources).</p> <p>Home corner roles - children to use existing knowledge to support their learning.</p> <p>Children to use their phonic awareness and physical development to mark make and 'write for purpose' during their role play activities.</p> <p>Children to introduce their own number activities in play and to fins their own fascinations with number in the environment.</p>
<p>In Literacy and Communication and Language we shall learn about</p>	<p>We will recognise phase 2 phonics sounds and begin to form them accuaretly.</p> <p>We will read phase 2 sounds in the environment.</p> <p>We will listen to, and re-tell stories sequencing events and discussing characters and events.</p> <p>We will hear initial sounds in simple words and write them.</p> <p>We will begin to segment phase 2 sounds in CVC words.</p> <p>We will speak clearly in small groups and 1:1.</p>

<p>In Mathematics we shall learn about</p>	<p>We will recognise numerals in the environment. We will count reliably up to 10 and then 20. We will match numerals and values for numbers to 5/10/20. We will begin to form numbers accurately and use these in play. We will use our number knowledge and apply this to real play situations.</p>
<p>In Understanding the World we shall learn about</p>	<p>People and communities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will explore jobs and roles related to transport. • We will understand that people travel for different reasons • We will recognise and respect similarities and differences between ourselves and others. <p>The world-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will observe plants and animals in the world around us and recognise similarities and differences. • We will talk about things I have observed, such as plants and animals in the natural world around us. • We will explore forms of travel by road/rail/sea/air. <p>Technology</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will use ICT to interact with age appropriate software. • We will choose technology for different purposes. • We will recognise how technology is used in different places.
<p>In Expressive arts and Design</p>	<p>We will join in with dancing and expressive activities. Sing familiar songs, and dance when I hear music that I know. We will use construction equipment to create my own structures, enclosures and vehicles. We will use different tools and media to represent our own ideas. We will use different tools and techniques to change materials.</p>
<p>In SEAL we shall learn about</p>	<p>We will learn to recognise the feelings of others and how we can have an impact upon other peoples feelings, and be sensitive to them.</p>
<p>In PE and Physical Development we shall learn about</p>	<p>Basketball - we will learn to control and use a range of sizes of balls and other equipment. We will develop skills of throwing, catching, pushing, and patting balls.</p>
<p>In ICT we shall learn about</p>	<p>We will learn how to access the technology in school. We will learn how to use computer hardware to complete simple software programmes.</p>
<p>Additional information:</p>	<p>PE will be done on Wednesday mornings and possibly Tuesday afternoons when we become more confident with changing independently. Please bring PE kit on a Monday morning and take it home to be washed at the weekend. If any parents would like to sign up to be a mystery reader on Thursday afternoons at 14:30 please sign up on the list outside Red Base. CAN ALL PARENTS PLEASE NOTE: When the bell rings in Red Base each morning that is the time for children to join us for register.
