Biig is an initiative at Broomhill Infant School which has been set up by parents in school to offer informal support to families of children with additional support needs.

## **Bus Rota - Broomhill to Nether Green Junior School**

This is for households in Broomhill with children in Y3 / Y4s at Nether Green Junior wanting to go, as a group, by 120 bus from Broomhill to Nether Green (to start from Monday 2nd October).

The rota will mean each household volunteering an adult, every few days, to accompany children to school, and children from those households can join in 1 to 5 mornings a week.

We would agree between the group suitable adult / child ratios once we know numbers of participants and that will set the frequency of volunteering - we're hoping adults will need to help about once a week.

The meeting point will be the bus stop in Broomhill on the Glossop Rd by the S10 Butchers. The meeting time is 0815h (for the bus timed to leave the Hallamshire Hospital at 0819h, which arrives at Nether Green school by 0835h).

Additionally if there are people wanting to also arrange a walking group from that bus stop in Broomhill to Broomhill Infant School at 0815h, that may be possible too, depending on numbers.

We're going to set this up via a WhatsApp group but we will also use SMS / text and email.
